ORDINANCE

CHESNEE DOG LAW

PROVISIONS:

*It is unlawful for any dog owner to allow his dog to run at large on the streets or public places unless it is under restraint of its owner, and the dog displays a tag showing it has been vaccinated against rabies within the preceding 12 months.*

*It is unlawful for any person to keep a vicious dog unless under restraint by fence, chain, or other means.*

*It is unlawful for the owner of any female dog to let her run at large during estrus.*

*The Police, town officials, employees of designated agents of the town may seize all dogs running at large, vicious or dangerous, and impound them. Any person may seize any such dog found on his property and deliver it to officials to be impounded.*

*Dangerous dogs may be destroyed. Dangerous dogs running in packs, even if wearing identification and rabies tabs, may be destroyed if declared public nuisances.*

*Any dog running at large, whether dangerous or not, which has no identification collar or rabies tags shall be deemed as abandoned property and may be impounded or destroyed.*

*If a dog is seized under the provisions of this article and the owner attempts to recover the dog, the owner shall be subject to a fine not in excess of \$100.*

*If a dog is not claimed in three days, officials have the authority to dispose of it.*

*Any owner who fails to respond to a notice that his dog has been declared a nuisance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.*

*It is unlawful for any person to own a dog that has not been inoculated against rabies within the preceding 12 months by a licensed veterinarian.*

*Copies of this ordinance will be available at City Hall for any resident owning a dog.*

## ORDINANCE
